Kindly be aware that all fees will undergo an annual review. School tuition fees may be adjusted to accommodate the continuous development of programs and external factors such as inflation and the overall economy. Payment of fees is required on a term-by-term basis and in advance. The fees provided below may vary based on the specific student.

Additional Fees Include:

Books, lunch and snacks, student card (1,000 THB refundable on return of undamaged unit), accident insurance, damage waiver fee, printing fee, technology (ICT) and media fee, Special Educational Needs (within school policy), all assessments fees (Year 6 and Year 9 external Cambridge Checkpoint, GCSE and A level examinations are subject to an additional charge. Fee charged at time of examination.) Use of the library and borrowing of books, documentation fees, all learning resources and manipulatives, swimming and sporting fees (during academic timetable).

In addition to the fees listed above, there are some charges which will be billed to parents separately. These fees are for items that are either on a per-student basis or optional fees for activities that are supplementary to the curriculum and learning. These include fees for items such as uniforms, transportation, late pick-up fees, some after school programmes (CCA's), examinations and individual music tuition. A detailed list of these fees can be found below. Please contact our school office for details.

INTENSIVE LEARNING PROGRAMME

If your child requires additional learning support, any costs incurred will be agreed upon with the parents full and transparent knowledge.

CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES (CCA's) - After academic sessions daily

A full programme will be sent to parents on a termly basis. Parents can select activities for their child/ children and additional fees will be incurred.

SCHOOL UNIFORM

Uniforms can be purchased from the school office.

SCHOOL TRANSPORT

A school bus service is available on request. The cost of this depends upon the distance from the school.

WITHDRAWAL POLICY

School fees are charged per term basis and a minimum of 90 days notice is required for withdrawal.

SIBLING DISCOUNT*

A 5% sibling discount is available for each additional child enrolled in the school at the same time. The sibling discount will be applied to the younger child's tuition fee.

ANNUAL PAYMENT DISCOUNT*

A 2% discount will be applied if the full AY2023 – 2024 fees are paid by the Term 1 due date.

**Discounts will be applied only to the annual tuition fee. The Sibling Discount and Annual Payment Discount cannot be used in conjunction with each other.*

TUITION AND FEES POLICY

I. PAYMENT SCHEDULE

Tuition and fees for current students are due and payable before the beginning of each semester. Tuition and fees for the 1st Term starting in August are due and payable the first two weeks of June. Tuition and fees for the 2nd Term starting in January are due and payable the first two weeks of November. Tuition and fees for the 3rd Term starting in April are due and payable the first two weeks of February.

II. PAYMENT OPTIONS

III. LATE PAYMENT

A late payment charge of 2,000 Baht per time will be imposed on late tuition payment.

IV. LATE ENROLLMENT

Continual Re-enrollment

Tuition fees will be pro-rated for late enrollment according to the following schedule.

New Enrollment Only

Tuition fees will be pro-rated according to the attendance days. Pro-rates are only applicable to tuition fees. No other school fees will be pro-rated.

V. EARLY WITHDRAWAL

Tuition fee refunds will be granted in accordance with the following schedule: From the 1st school day to the 5th day of the term 75%

From the 6th school day to the 10th day of the term 50%
From the 11th school day to the 15th day of the term 25%

From the 16th school day to the end of the term No refund

NB: Number of days are counted by school calendar days, not attendance days.

VI. NON-RETURN or NON-APPEARANCE

Returning students who do not appear at school in the first month of the semester, August 2023, October 2023, January 2024 or March 2024 without prior notice in writing in advance to the Principal/Director of Academics, automatically forfeit their student status at Invictus and shall be treated as new students upon returning to the school.

New students who have enrolled and paid all school fees will receive full refund for all school fees, except for the Admissions Fee, if withdrawal is indicated before the term commences. Early withdrawal policy (para- graph V) is applicable to new students who withdraw after the term commences.

VII. RECEIPT OF PAYMENTS

Receipt of payments will be issued specifying the description of fees and the actual amounts paid ONLY.

VIII. OVERDUE TUITION PAYMENT

Where fees are not paid by the due date, Invictus reserves the right to proceed as follows:

1. Withhold all school documents.
2. Discontinue enrollment for the following academic year.
3. Suspend from testing. All previous scores will be withheld.
4. Take legal action in the collection of outstanding tuition fees.
